TRYOUT AND EVALUATION POLICY

PREAMBLE

TASA Minor Hockey Association (“TASA”) aims to host competitive teams at as many divisions and levels as registration and skill allows. A tryout procedure will be implemented to meet this goal.

POLICY

TASA will conduct fair evaluations (“tryouts”) for all levels of competitive hockey for all TASA members (players) who are interested in playing competitive hockey. Players **MUST** indicate their desire to play at the competitive level on their registration and submit their registration by the indicated deadline.

TASA will conduct a fair evaluation process for all players who are interested in playing at the C level (formerly known as ‘House’ or ‘Recreational’).

TASA will conduct a fair evaluation process for all players in U7/U9 so that players will be placed for best opportunities for development.

TASA will charge fees for all players to cover any costs associated with the tryout process for competitive hockey. Costs for the evaluation process for C levels shall be included in the registration fee.

PROCEDURE(S)

TASA will communicate tryout and evaluation dates and procedures to its membership using, but not limited to, email to registered membership and TASA website updates.
